PREAMBLE

The purpose of this non-profit, unincorporated organization is to foster closer cooperation and improved communications between students of electronic journalism, journalism educators, and professional practitioners of radio and television news; to afford members special learning opportunities both in and out of the classroom; and to instill a commitment to the highest ideals and principles of the practice of electronic journalism, as exemplified by the Radio Television Digital News Association.

ARTICLE II Membership

- 1. Voting membership shall be limited to students in good standing of this institution who are pursuing a career in broadcast or electronic journalism.
- 2. Membership shall not be denied for reasons of age, race, color, creed, sex, national origin, or disability.
- 3. Membership shall consist of a minimum of five (5) student members of RTDNA.
- 4. The Chapter advisor shall be a faculty or staff member of the institution involved in the teaching or production of electronic or broadcast journalism and shall be a member of RTDNA.

ARTICLE III

Officers

- 1. The Officers of the Chapter shall form the Board of Directors.
- 2. The Officers shall include a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. At the discretion of the Chapter, the positions of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined into one Secretary-Treasurer.
- 3. The Officers of the Chapter shall be elected in the manner prescribed by the Chapter.

ARTICLE IV

Meetings

- 1. The Board of Directors shall meet a minimum of two (2) times per academic year.
 - a. One meeting shall closely follow the election of officers meeting.
 - b. A second meeting shall closely follow the beginning of the academic year.
- 2. The Chapter will hold a minimum of two (2) business meetings, open to members and prospective members, per academic year.
 - a. One of these meetings shall be the election of officers meeting.
